The Capital Regional Council is pleased to announce its THIRTY-FIFTH Annual Low Test Figure Skating Competition. The competition will be held under the general rules of US FIGURE SKATING governing competitions as set forth in the Official Rule Book and will be open to qualified eligible skaters who are members in good standing and members of the above participating clubs, or to individual members of US FIGURE SKATING living within the boundaries of Maryland, Virginia, or the District of Columbia. **No-Test Entrants** must be 6 years of age by the close of entries 2-23-10. At least one partner in a pair or Adult dance event must be a member in good standing of the above participating clubs or an individual member of US Figure skating living within the boundaries of Maryland, Virginia, or the District of Columbia; the other partner in the pair may be a member of any US Figure Skating Club or be an individual member of US Figure Skating living outside the boundaries stated above. **Skaters entering Pre-Preliminary and above for Freestyle or Moves or Spins may skate 1 level higher if desired. Intermediate Short and Long programs will be separate events; however, the trophy will be awarded to those who have entered the combined event.**

ENTRY FEES – The entry fee for Singles (No-Test through Intermediate) will be \$70 per person; for Intermediates entering both the Short and Long events, the fee will be \$110 per person, and for Pairs and Dance, \$35 per person. The entry fee for Compulsory Moves or Spins will be \$40 per person. Checks or money orders should be made payable to: **CAPITAL REGIONAL COUNCIL or CRC**

There will be no refunds after 2/23/10, in accordance with the 2010 US FIGURE SKATING Rule Book, and no refunds will be made because of competition cancellation due to Acts of God. A fee of \$20.00 will be charged for every check returned because of insufficient funds.

ENTRY FORM – The completed ENTRY FORM (Page 5) and ACCIDENT FORM (Page 6) **MUST** be **POSTMARKED** no later than **February 23, 2010** and mailed to:

GENERAL INFORMATION – In case of a large number of entries per level, divisions will be made by club/age. An event must have TWO entries to be held. If a skater withdraws leaving a single entrant, the event will be canceled. Mt. Vernon's ice surface is 85'X200" with rounded corners and barrier.

MUSIC – Competition music must be submitted on CD's only. Due to compatibility issues, do **NOT** submit re-recordable "CD-RW" discs. CD's must be turned in and picked up at the registration desk. All music must be clearly marked with the competitor's name and event. **PLEASE HAVE A SPARE CD ACCESSIBLE AT RINKSIDE** in case of a problem. CRC assumes **NO** responsibility for CD's not picked up by the end of the competition.

AWARDS – Medals will be awarded for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places.

ADULT – SILVER	Age 25 or older by 2-23-10	Not to exceed 2:10 Min. Competitors must have passed Adult Bronze FS Test & no higher than the Adult Silver FS Test, the standard US FIGURE SKATING Juvenile FS Test, the 2 nd Figure Test prior to Oct. 1, 1977, or ISI FS 5. NO Double Jumps Allowed.
ADULT – BRONZE	Age 25 or older by 2-23-10	Not to exceed 1:50 Min. Competitors must have passed Adult Bronze FS Test, the standard US FIGURE SKATING Preliminary FS Test, the 2 nd Figure Test prior to Oct. 1, 1977, or ISI FS 4. No Axel or Double Jumps Allowed.
ADULT – SPECIAL	Age 18 – 24 by 2-23-10	Not to exceed 2:10 Min. No higher than Juvenile FS Test or ISI FS 5, No Double Jumps Allowed.

PAIRS EVENTS

PRELIMINARY	Preliminary Pair Test	1½ Minutes
PRE-JUVENILE	Pre-Juvenile Pair Test	2 Minutes
JUVENILE	Juvenile Pair Test	2 Minutes 30 seconds
INTERMEDIATE	Juvenile or Intermediate Pair Test	3 Minutes

NOTES:

1. The allowable time of all singles and pairs freeskating events (excluding Short Program and Adult events) is +/- 10 seconds of the time listed in the tables above under "Program Time".
2. Juvenile and Intermediate entrants who placed first through fourth in the Final Round of the 2010 Juvenile and Intermediate Regional Competition are ineligible to enter that same level.
3. Depending on the number of entries in Juvenile and Intermediate Freestyle and if time permits, a Final Round will be held and shall consist of the Free Skating Program.

COMPULSORY MOVES

Compulsory Moves Events for skaters who have passed the Pre-Preliminary Freeskate or higher may be skated at the same level or one level up from their Free Skate level. Compulsory Moves Events are intended to prepare the skater for the short program. For all classes, the moves may be skated in any order. Moves in the Field elements should be recognizable and may be used as connecting moves. It is not necessary to do as many Moves in the Field repetitions as are required in the tests.

NO TEST- A program of 1 minute or less, skated without music on one-half the ice surface.

1. TOE LOOP
2. SALCHOW
3. WALTZ JUMP
4. FORWARD RIGHT & LEFT SPIRALS
5. ONE FOOT SPIN (minimum 3 revolutions)

PRE-PRELIMINARY - A program of 1 minute or less, skated without music on one-half the ice surface

1. LOOP JUMP
2. SALCHOW
3. JUMP COMBINATION OF WALTZ JUMP/TOE LOOP
4. FORWARD TO BACK SPIRAL
5. CAMEL SPIN (minimum 3 revolutions)

PRELIMINARY – A program of 1-1 1/2 minutes or less, without music on one-half the ice surface.

1. FORWARD POWER 3 TURNS
2. WALTZ JUMP/TOE LOOP JUMP COMBINATION (no turn or step between)
3. CONSECUTIVE OUTSIDE & INSIDE SPIRALS
4. FLIPJUMP
5. SIT SPIN (minimum 3 revolutions in the sit position)
6. ALTERNATING FORWARD 3 TURNS (**DO NOT DO THIS ON A LINE...USE AS CONNECTING STEPS**)

PRE-JUVENILE – A program of 1-1 1/2 minutes or less, without music on one-half the ice surface.

1. FLIP-LOOP JUMP COMBINATION (no turn or step between)
2. FORWARD & BACKWARD POWER CHANGE OF EDGE PULLS
3. 5 STEP MOHAWK SEQUENCE
4. LUTZ JUMP
5. COMBINATION SPIN: CAMEL to SIT (no change of foot) (minimum 6 revolutions)
6. 3 TURNS IN THE FIELD
7. FRONT SCRATCH TO BACK SCRATCH (exit on spinning foot) (minimum 4 revolutions on each foot)

JUVENILE - A program of 1½ minutes or less, without music, on full ice surface.

1. AXEL
2. LUTZ JUMP
3. JUMP COMBINATION – 2 Single Jumps (no turn or change of foot between)
4. SIT SPIN (minimum 4 revolutions in sit position)
5. COMBINATION SPIN – (with 1 change of foot & 4 revolutions on each foot)
6. ANY SPIRAL
7. 8 STEP MOHAWK SEQUENCE
8. FORWARD DOUBLE 3 TURNS (outer and inner)
9. BACKWARD POWER 3 TURNS

SPINS

Spin Events for skaters who have passed the Pre-Preliminary Freeskate or higher, may be skated at the same level or one level up from their Free Skate level. For all classes, the spins may be skated in any order.

NO TEST, PRE-PRELIMINARY – A program of 1 minute or less, skated without music on one-half the ice surface with connecting moves.

1. 2 foot spin – minimum of 3 revolutions
2. 1 foot spin – minimum of 3 revolutions
3. Sit Spin – minimum of 3 revolutions in the sitting position

PRELIMINARY – A program of 1 minute or less, without music on one-half the ice surface with connecting moves.

1. Camel Spin – minimum of 3 revolutions
2. Sit Spin – minimum of 3 revolutions in the sitting position
3. Scratch Spin – minimum of 3 revolutions

PRE-JUVENILE, JUVENILE – A program of 1 minute or less, without music on one-half the ice surface with connecting moves.

1. Flying Spin – minimum of 4 revolutions
2. Sit change Sit – minimum of 4 revolutions
3. Combination Spin with one change of foot and 2 changes of position – minimum of 4 revolutions on each foot

INTERMEDIATE – A program of 1 minute or less, without music on one-half the ice surface with connecting moves

1. Flying Spin – minimum of 5 revolutions
2. Combination Spin with one change of foot and 2 changes of position – minimum of 5 revolutions on each foot
3. One spin of choice – minimum of 5 revolutions

ADULT & ADULT MASTERS INTERPRETIVE EVENT

Requirements are the same as those as in the 2010 Adult Nationals. Please refer to the USFS website: http://www.usfigureskating.org/event_details.asp?id=42207 for the rules

SYNCHRONIZED SKATING

SYNCHRONIZED TEAMS – Open to skaters at all test levels. Teams must be members of clubs in the Capital Regional Council.

Requirements are those of section 4600 of the USFS 2010 Rulebook,
